**LIST OF SPECIES OF FUNGI RECORDED ON 13<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2012.**

(Nomenclature after Legon N. W. and Henrici A. 2005. Checklist of the British and Irish Basidiomycota. London: Royal Botanic Gardens Kew).

*Agrocybe molesta* - Provisional identification.

*Arrhenia obscurata* – Formerly *Omphalina obscurata*. Usually found on acid soil, but usually in grassland.

*Armillaria mellea* Honey fungus

*Bolbitius vitellinus*

*Bovista nigrescens*

*Collybia dryophila*

*Coniophora puteana*

*Conocybe brunneola*

*Coprinus lagopus*

*Coprinus plicatilis*

*Crepidotus epibryus* - on dead grass by beehives.

*Crepidotus variabilis*

*Daedaleopsis confragosa* Blushing Bracket

*Flammulina velutipes*

*Galerina hypnorum*

*Lepiota procera* Parasol Mushroom

*Lepiota rhacodes* – Scaly Parasol; one poor specimen in edge of orchard.

*Cystolepiota seminuda* – formerly a true *Lepiota* as *L. sistrata*.

*Melanoleuca melaleuca*

*Melanoleuca polioleuca*

*Mycena acicula*

*Mycena capillaris* – on ivy leaf in edge of orchard.

*Mycena eipterygia* – provisional identification.

*Mycena galopus*

*Mycena haematopus* – on decaying cherry wood.

*Mycena hiemalis* – on bark of a cherry tree, amongst moss.

*Panaeolina foenisecii* - a common dung fungus.

*Panaeolus olivaceus* – usually on unimproved grassland.

*Panellus stipticus* – saprophytic on cherry.

*Phellinus sp* – on cherry trunk.

*Pleurotus dryinus* - Provisional identification.

*Psathyrella corrugis* – on buried twigs?

*Stereum rugosum*

*Trametes versicolor* – On buried wood?

*Tubaria furfuracea*

*Volvariella bombycina* – On unidentified wood.

*Boletus chrysenteron / cisalpinus* – Probably the former. Too decayed to determine.
